A funeral Mass for Frederick P. Buechler, 77, of Rochester, was held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday in St. Pius X Catholic Church, with the Rev Paul Nelson officiating. Burial was at Calvary Cemetery.

Mr. Buechler died Tuesday (Aug. 9, 2005) at his home after a lengthy illness. He was born July 1, 1928, in Perham, Minn. After high school, he entered the armed forces, serving from 1946 to 1948. He attended St John's University and graduated from St Cloud State with a teaching degree. He taught at Red Lake Falls, Minn., from 1951 to 1956 and at Long Prairie, Minn., from 1956 to 1964. He was a member of Kiwanis, head of the Terrific Kids program, and a member of the National Education Association, MEA, and the National Science Teachers Association. He enjoyed golf and fishing.

Surviving are his wife; four sons, Tim (Karin) of Rochester, Tom (Michele) of Mantorville, Bruce (Cindy) of Denver, Colo., and Robb (Kelly) of Rogers, Minn.; three daughters, Barbara (Brent McAbee) Buechler of Wilmington, N.C., Lori (Peter) Vogel of Deerfield, Wis., and LuAnn (Willia m "Watty" Watson) Buechler of Byron; 16 grandchildren; three great-grandcholdren; and a sister, Rosella (La Vern) Nelson of Lakeville, Minn. 
