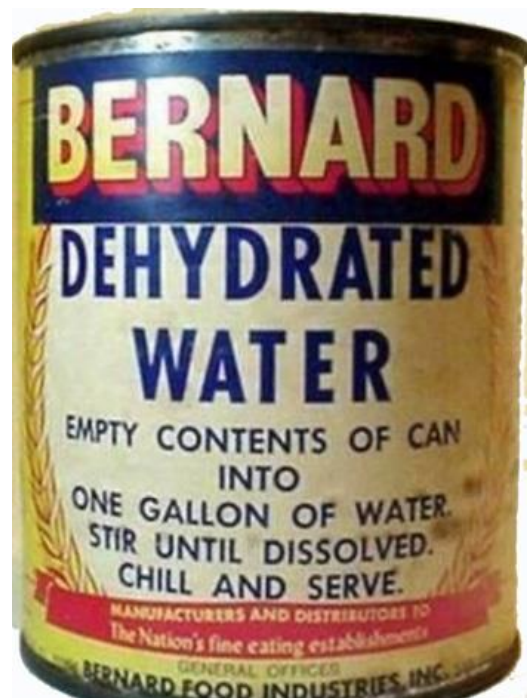
I'm still in the process of buying 2100 pairs of gloves/ mittens for our over 700 families that we serve.

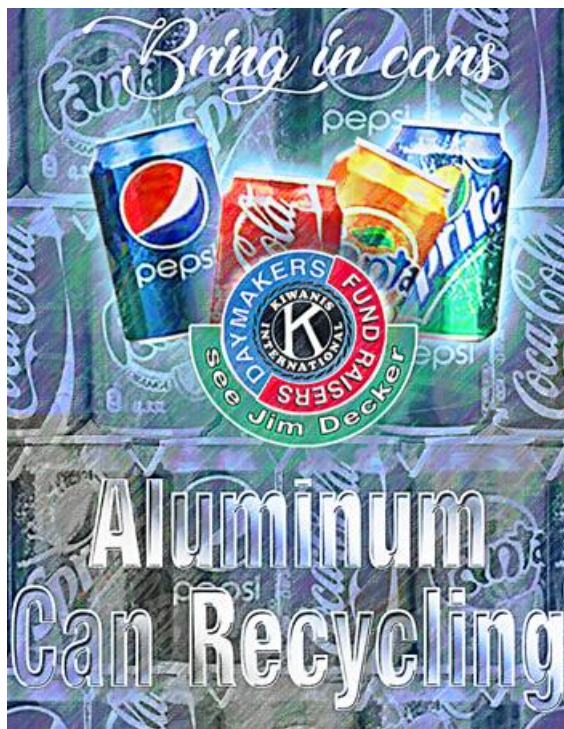

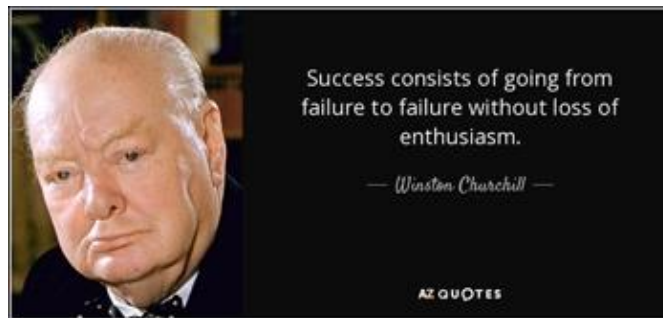
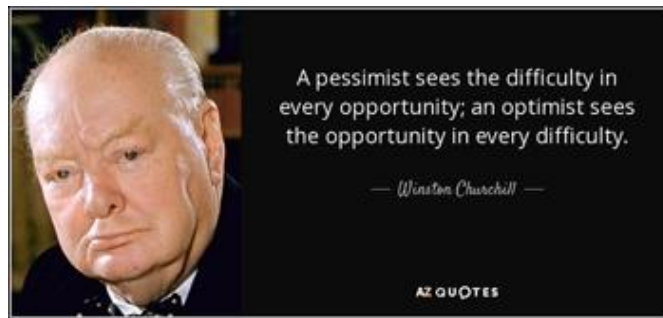

Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting: Ken Reding moved and Garry Post seconded to approve the minutes from the September 14, 2021, Board Meeting.

Treasurer's Report as of September 30, 2021: The printed report was sent out to all board members preceding the meeting. It was filed as presented by consensus of the board members.

OLD BUSINESS:

Kathy reported that a board meeting was to be held on Wednesday so we should get and update on our profit from the sale of Rochesterfest Buttons soon.

Jim Decker reported that he had nothing new from our last board meeting, which was that the Hockey Festival is scheduled for December 28, 29 and 30th. We have 10 teams scheduled for the festival. We have \$20,000.00 to raise through the selling of ads and/or donations to the program. We are trying for 40 advertisers for the program booklet.

Jack reported that the rose sale was completed with a profit of \$658.15 for selling 112 dozen and gifting 3 dozen to Charlies Restaurant and two wait staff members who serve us weekly. We may be looking at and increase to \$20.00 per dozen for next year to increase our profit line.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was moved by Jack and seconded by Kathy Davis to approve a leave of absence for Larry Segar from November 2021 through April 2022. **Approved**

OTHER BUSINESS:

Ruth Vrieze the signup for the scheduled times for Bell Ringing has been very good. She will work with the Salvation Army on setting up possibly getting some more time slots for Bell Ringing for our membership.
