<u>Approval of Agenda:</u> It was moved, by Jim Decker and seconded by Herb Erickson to approve the agenda. **Approved** 

**Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:** Herb Erickson moved, and Kathy Davis seconded to approve the minutes from the January 11, 2022, Board Meeting. **Approved** 

Treasurer's Report as of November 30, 2021: The printed report was sent out to all board members preceding the meeting. Kathy Davis moved, and Helen Kolb seconded the motion to approve the report as printed. Carried

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Discussion was held regarding the "K" Dollars that our club members are donating. It will be announced at an upcoming meeting the feeling of the board for the usage and discussion by the membership and their input on how to disperse.

Should we keep some or all the dollars brought in locally, as part of our fundraising efforts, or should we send it all or part to the Kiwanis Children's Fund. Consensus of the board was to keep some of the funds locally.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Jim Decker commented that the audit of the books for the 2021-2022 Kiwanis Year for the first quarter will be conducted on Tuesday February 15<sup>th</sup> by himself, director Bruce Keller and Jack Zierdt.

Kathy Davis reported that she is working with the parks department on the possible donation of a Kiwanis Bench at one or more parks in the City of Rochester.

On behalf of the committee he moved that the Performing Arts Category should be removed. Helen Kolb seconded the motion. **The Board approved the motion.** 

**Early Childhood Committee** Linda reported that she has the SMIF books in her garage and that she will bring books to our future meetings to put stickers in them. She will also be contacting the schools, day cares and nursery schools for future distribution of the books.

Membership Committee: Jim Schwinghammer reported that Charlies is willing to donate \$10 gift certificates to those sponsoring new Day Maker Members. He will explore this with him to see how many and if it will be retroactive. The committee will meet at 9:00 AM on Thursday February 17<sup>th</sup> at Charlies.

**Program:** Jim Cook reported that we need programs for our weekly meetings during the months of February and March. It was decided by Jim and the Board that the February 15<sup>th</sup> program would be presentations by various members of the Day Makers about some of our various projects and activities. **Strategic Planning:** Nothing new to report.

Fundraising: It was decided by the Board with the committee chair that we should work on the ones that we presently have and not add any new ones at this time. We will explore increasing the total number of Roses that we sell this coming fall.

Human and Spiritual: It was reported that Naomi Schneider (Bill's Daughter) would be living at the house so cards could be sent to his address. Cards that were sent out were a sympathy card to the family of Bill Schneider, and Thinking of you cards to Herb Erickson, Jim Cook, and Curt Pearson.

Youth Services: Ken Reding stated that all volunteering in the schools is determined by Volunteer Services of Rochester Public Schools. At the present time nothing is happening at Elton Hills Elementary School and Riverside Central Elementary School is presently shut down for K-kids and Terrific Kids for Kiwanis Volunteers

Herb Erickson moved, and Jim Cook seconded the motion to adjourn. **Approved**
