Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting: Ken Reding moved, and Larry Scilley seconded to approve the minutes from the May 10, 2022, Board Meeting. Approved Treasurer's Report as of April 30, 2022: The printed report was sent out to all board members preceding the meeting.
