Christmas Anonymous 2021 Update:

The 2021 edition of Christmas Anonymous is planned to happen on Saturday December 11 back at Christ United Methodist Church. The intent is to return to format of past years except for 2020. Beth Kosta is the new president, and she is working closely with the county health department to ensure all standards are followed.

While planning is preliminary and subject to change it is the intent to get the store day back to close to normal. Several changes will occur, as we know the bike program has ended and while there are about 60 bikes in storage that are repaired; most are adult bikes. So, it may be decided to forgo them entirely.

All food will again be boxed at Channel One (hopefully) and distributed from a truck parked on the street and senior food delivered. There will be no frozen meat or fruit.

There are questions whether the schools will be able to donate as in previous years and thus if we will be allowed to pick up donations. The KTTC toy drive is also in question.

For our part, we will begin on Saturday Nov. 27 by hauling about 30 tables and carts from storage to CUMC. On Dec. 6, with the help of the county sheriff's department we will move in the tables borrowed from the fair board. On Thursday Dec. 7, material from the storage bins will be moved to CUMC. I've been told we will be assisted by the Grizzlies hockey team and will be checking with the county on Sentenced to Serve.

A big priority is returning items to storage following store day. We won't have the luxury of doing it Monday as last year because of the need to clear material from the church for Sunday (although tables will be moved Monday).

As you can see, things may change but hopefully making Christmas happier for those in need will continue.

Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting: Herb Erickson moved and Jim Decker to approve the minutes from the August 17, 2021, Board Meeting. **Approved**

Treasurer's Report as of July 31, 2021: The printed report was sent out to all board members preceding the meeting. It was moved by Jim Cook and seconded by Garry Post to approve the report. Approved
The motion was made by Helen Kolb and seconded by Ruth Vrieze to appoint Jim Decker to do an internal audit at the end of the 2020-2021 Kiwanis Year. Approved It was decided to leave the signing of checks with only one signature as has been the practice since the beginning of the club.

OLD BUSINESS:

Kathy reported that we should be receiving \$270 as our profit for the selling of Rochesterfest Buttons. Jim Decker reported on the present situation for the Hockey Festival scheduled for December 28, 29 and 30^{th.} We have 10 teams scheduled for the festival. We have \$20,000.00 to raise through the selling of ads and/or donations to the program. We are trying for 40 advertisers for the program booklet.

NEW BUSINESS:

Jack Zierdt presented a bill for reimbursement for purchasing the 3 cases of backpacks (\$271.71) and ink used for printings. 3 months of charges at \$27.02 per month (\$81.06). The total of \$352.77 was submitted to the board on a motion by Herb Erickson and seconded by Linda Rouhoff. **Approved**

The projected budget for the 2021-2022 Kiwanis Year was presented for final approval by Jack Zierdt to the board. Herb Erickson moved and Garry Post seconded the budget should be approved. **Approved**

The annual meeting luncheon on September 28th at 11:45AM will be paid for by the Day Makers Kiwanis Club. It was decided to ask for a free will offering to help defray some of the expenses.

Ruth Vrieze brought up the information that she has been contacted, by the Salvation Army, to schedule times for Bell Ringing. She will work with the Salvation Army on setting up a schedule for signups by our membership. Zoom Meetings (Hybrid) will continue until further notice.
