

**Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting:** Ken Reding moved, and Jim Decker seconded to approve the minutes from the October 19, 2021, Board Meeting. **Approved** 

Treasurer's Report as of September 30, 2021: The printed report was sent out to all board members preceding the meeting. Helen moved and Kathy seconded the motion to approve the minutes with a correction to the Rose Sale Income Amount. Carried OLD BUSINESS:

Kathy reported that we received \$212.50 as our profit from the sale of Rochesterfest Buttons.

Jim Decker reported that the Hockey Festival is scheduled for December 28, 29 and 30<sup>th</sup> and that signup sheets for workers would be out soon. We have 10 teams scheduled for the festival. We have \$20,000.00 to raise through the selling of ads and/or donations to the program. We are trying for 40 advertisers for the program booklet.

Jim Decker reported that the audit of the books for the 2020-2021 Kiwanis Year had been completed by himself, Bruce Keller, and Garry Post. The reconciliation process of examining all the financial transactions of the Day Makers books resulted in a Satisfactory Audit. (Report from Committee is attached to file copy of minutes.) A motion was made by Linda Rouhoff and seconded by Dave Bhaskaran to accept the Audit Report. **Motion Carried!** 

Kathy Davis reported that she needed school age hats and mittens for the upcoming Christmas Anonymous project.

Program: Jim Cook reported that we have weekly meeting programs scheduled through the month of November.

Strategic Planning: Nothing new to report.
